3. Application method: Application documents screening and interview.

4. Interview method

The candidate may choose one of the two following interview methods:

- On-site interview: Candidates are requested to go to VJU campus to participate in a face-to-face interview with the admission committee;

- Online interview: Only those candidates who cannot join on-site interview at VJU campus due to geographical or work conditions may propose the admissions committee to allow them to take online interview via Internet connection.

5. Location and duration of study

- Duration of study: 02 years.

- Location of study: VNU Vietnam Japan University, Luu Huu Phuoc street, Cau Dien ward, Nam Tu Liem district, Hanoi.

II. ORGANIZING ADMISSION

1. Diploma and professional experience

- For qualification and working experience requirements of each Master's program, please check Appendix 1.

- Applicants expecting to receive their bachelor's degree before September 30, 2020 can apply for admission to a VJU Master's program right now and submit supplementary documents before the official opening of the program.

2. Language proficiency requirements

2.1. English requirement for each Master's Program

At the date of submission, the applicant must possess an English language proficiency that meets one of the following requirements:

a) Holding a valid English certificate within 2 years from the exam date to the date of submission and was issued by an institution recognized by VNU. For those 10 instututes issues Vietnamese 6-level of foreign language ability framework, please refer for the validity in appendix 2.

+ For Master's programs in Public Policy, Business Administration and Global Leadership: The English certificate must be at least level 4/6 (B2) or equivalent.

+ For Master's programs in Nanotechnology; Infrastructure Engineering; Environmental Engineering; Area Studies; Climate Change and Development: The English certificate must be at least level 3/6 (B1) or equivalent. After one year studying at VJU, student must submit n English certificate of level 4/6 (B2) to be recognized as an official student of the university.

b) Holding a bachelor's degree or a master's degree, or a Ph.D. degree of an English-medium full-time study program in a country where English is used as the official language. The degree must be recognized by relevant agencies in accordance with current regulations.

c) Holding a bachelor's degree of an advanced training program under MoET's Project on advanced training in some Vietnamese universities; Graduated from talented, international, advanced, honor bachelor's program or master's program which have foreign language expected learning outcome equivalent to the level 4/6 onward of Vietnamese 6-level of foreign language ability framework within 2 years to the date of admission (*expiry date does not apply to VNU's degree*).

d) Holding a bachelor's degree major in English language.

2.2. Language requirements of Master's program in Area Studies (MAS).

In addition to the English language requirement as in section 2.1, MAS program require proficiency in Vietnamese and Japanese. Specific requirement as follows: **For applicants applied for Japanese studies orientation*

The applicant must meet one of the following requirements in Japanese language proficiency:

a) Holding a Japanese language certificate issued by an institution recognized by VNU equivelant to N2 level or higher (Appendix 2) and must be within 2 years from the exam date to the date of submission.

b) Holding a bachelor's or master's or Ph.D.'s degree from a full-time Japanesemedium program.

c) Holding a bachelor's degree major in Japanese language. *For foreign applicants applied for Vietnamese studies orientation

a) Holding a Vietnamese language certificate level 4/6 of the Vietnamese language ability framework for foreigners issued by VNU University of Social Sciences and Humanities or an equivalent certificate issued by an institution licensed by the Ministry of Education and Training.

b) Holding a bachelor's or master's or Ph.D.'s degree from a full-time Vietnamesemedium program.

c) Holding a bachelor's degree major in Vietnamese language.

d) Holding a certificate of completion of the preparatory Vietnamese course offered

by VNU University of Social Sciences and Humanities or by an institution licensed by the Ministry of Education and Training.

2.3. Note on language requirement

In case the candidate (including Vietnamese and foreigners) may not present the proof of English/Japanese/Vietnamese language proficiency as required in the admission notice, the Judge subcommittee (including Japanese and Vietnamese professors, lecturer) will assess language skill (English or Japanese) of candidate based on the application documents and the interview process. Applicant must submit a language proficiency certificate to be recognized as an official student of the university.

Candidates apply for Master's programs in Area Studies, Nanotechnology, Environmental Engineering, Infrastructure Engineering, Climate Change and Development are required to have proof of language proficiency equivalent to the level. 3/6 (B1) at the time of application submission and level 4/6 (B2) after the end of the first year of study. If foreign language certificate is not available at the time of application, candidate can register for a foreign language exam at the same time of VNU postgraduate entrance exam. VNU's foreign language exam schedule will be specifically informed to each candidate.

3. Supplemetary courses

Vietnam Japan University organizes supplementary courses for candidates after having the conclusion of the Judges Subcommittee after evaluating documents and interviewing candidates. VJU will schedule supplementary courses after finishing the third interview. In case of successful candidates are indicated as required to study supplementary courses, candidates must complete the supplementary courses before recognized as official students of VJU.

4. Other requirements

- Good personal record (currently not under any kind of disciplinary higher than a warning);
- Good health for study;

- International students must possess proof of financial record/support that is sufficient for 2-years period of studying and living in Vietnam.

5. Organizing admission and interview

- Depending on the number of registered applicants and selected candidate for the interview, interview schedule will be arranged by Admission Council;

- Time of interview: Each candidate has about 10 - 30 minutes for the preparation and 15 - 30 minutes for the interview;

- Language of interview: Candidate will participate in the interview in English. For MAS program: Japanese studies orientation candidate shall be interviewed in Japanese and Vietnamese studies orientation candidate shall be interview in Vietnamese;

- Method of Interview: Members of Judge Sub-committee shall ask questions and candidate will answer the questions face-to-face directly. The interview process shall be recorded (in audio or video) and storage confidently in VJU archive according to current regulations on admission.

6. Requirement for successful candidate

- The minimum requirement for successful candidate is 50/100 points (including application dosiers screening, essay writting and interviewing).

The list of successful candidates will be sorted by admission score from the highest to the lowest to meet one of the two following criteria:

- Out of admission quota;

- Out of candidates whom satisfied the requirement of Admission committee.

Threshold of admission shall be indicated by the number of sucessfull candidates and admission quota.
